



NOTICE OF VOTE

TO: MEMBERS OF Brokenhead Ojibway NATION

TAKE NOTICE that a Ratification Vote will be held in accordance with the Brokenhead Ojibway Nation Community Ratification Process on **December 8, 9, 10, and 13, 2014** in order to determine if Registered Eligible Voters approve the ***Brokenhead Ojibway Nation Land Management Code*** and the **Individual Agreement**.

NOTE: February 5, 2015 may be used as a voting date if one or more of the December dates are cancelled due to weather.

The following question will be asked of the Registered Voters of Brokenhead Ojibway Nation by ballot:

“Do you approve:

- **The *Brokenhead Ojibway Nation Land Management Code*, dated October 31, 2014 and the Individual Agreement with Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Canada? “**

You will be asked to select [] Yes or [] No on your ballot

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that all Members of Brokenhead Ojibway Nation 18 years of age or older as of the date of the Ratification Vote are eligible to vote, **PROVIDED THAT SUCH MEMBERS MUST COMPLETE AND SIGN A VOTER REGISTRATION FORM 6**. Voter registration documents will be sent to Eligible Voters whose address is on record with the Brokenhead Ojibway Nation. Voter registration documents are also available from Burke A. Ratte, Ratification Officer at the address and telephone number appearing below.
